The A.M.O.R. project aims to address the pressing challenges posed by the COVID-19 crisis in the education sector, with a specific focus on the social skills gap and the digital divide. Targeting individuals with disabilities and special educational needs, who have often been overlooked by recent digital solutions due to accessibility issues.

The main goals of the project will be achieved through the creation of:

- Good Practice Catalogue: dedicated document available to the general public, with particular emphasis on its relevance to young people and social workers, as well as other professionals in the education sector.
- Digital Handbook: a distinct publication, encompasses numerous chapters designed for various objectives.
 Accessible to the public at no cost, with a special emphasis on its recommendation for educators and students, both with and without disabilities

A.M.O.R.focuses on empowering teachers, trainers, and social workers to support young people, especially those with disabilities, in overcoming challenges related to their perceived or real lack of control over their situation. The ultimate goal is to enhance active social participation and counteract the prevailing trends of exclusion exacerbated by the pandemic.
